Eligibility

B.Sc. (Hons. School): 10+2 Examination of Punjab School Education Board or any other equivalent examination with at least 50% marks in aggregate.

Admission will be based on merit of the candidate in the qualifying examination. Prof. Vikram Chandha, Head, Punjab School of Economics will be the Coordinator for admission.

M.Sc. (Hons. School): B.Sc. (Hons. School) in Economics/B.Sc. (Economics)/B.A. (Hons.) in Economics under 10+2+3 system with atleast 50% marks in aggregate Or B.A./B.Sc. under 10+2+3 system with atleast 50% marks in aggregate and atleast 50% marks in Economics, Or B.Com./B.B.A. under 10+2+3 system with atleast 50% marks in aggregate.

Master of Business Economics (MBE): Bachelor's degree (10+2+3) of Guru Nanak Dev University or any other degree recognised by the Guru Nanak Dev University as equivalent thereto with not less than 50% marks in aggregate.

Admission to the above courses will be based on merit of the candidate in the qualifying examination.

Special Features

Research efforts are mainly devoted to the study of Indian Economy with special focus on Punjab Economy. A Centre for Studies in Punjab Economy with financial assistance

from the University Grants Commission (UGC) to create a data bank as well as conduct studies on different aspects of the Punjab Economy has also been set up in the school. In addition, the UGC has selected the School for continuation under its Special Assistance Programme at DRS Level II.

Apart from the computer facility along with internet connection to individual faculty members, the School has two independent computer lab with internet facility for students also. The School also maintains a World Bank Depository Library.
